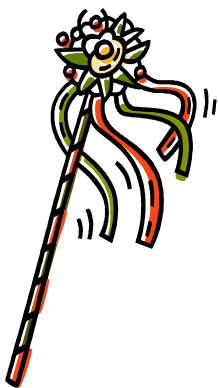
Senior Regent's Message

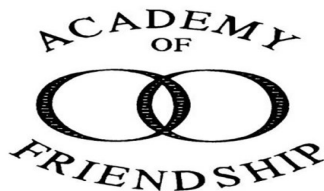

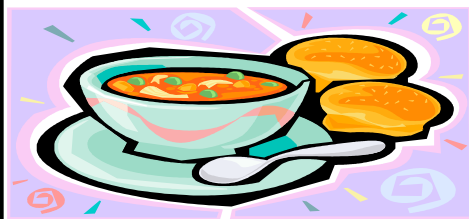

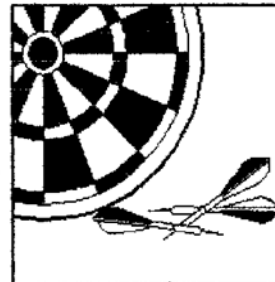
