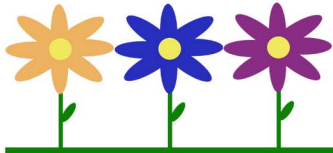

The Girls



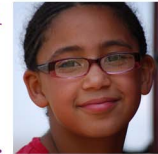
Autumn is the youngest resident of Washington Home. She is 8 years old and in second grade. She loves to play with dolls and barbies.



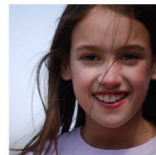

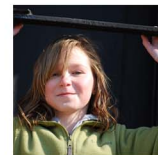
Alyssa is 9 years old and in the second grade. She loves to play games with the other girls in the home. She also loves to play with her dolls.
